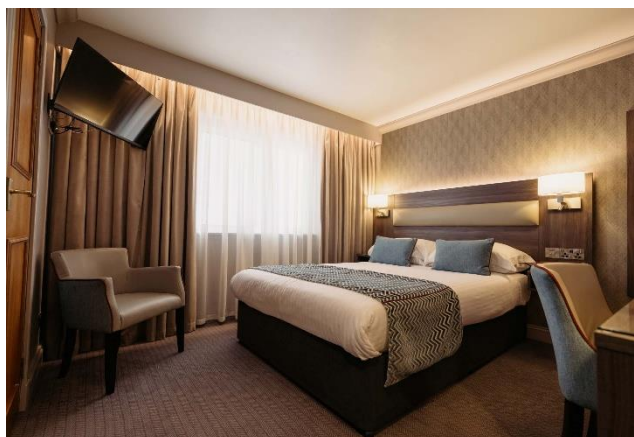




The Angus Hotel, Blairgowrie – A new Scottish hotel joins the Compass Hospitality group portfolio.
